**Current Featur** 

Congenital Heart Defect (CHD) Awareness Week highlights the preventative measures and screenings completed by healthcare partners throughout the state to detect and treat CHDs in newborns. These conditions affect approximately 1% of infants born in the United every year. Of those with a CHD, nearly one in four have a CHD (CCHD) which means the infant will need medical intion during the first year of life. CCHD screening is performed using a pulse oximetry device, which measures oxygen levels in the blood and may be helpful in identifying a possible health concern. Since 2014, the Newborn Screening Program has screened over 1.4 million babies born in Florida.

Enter the verification code provided in the email message to confirm and complete your registration.


