Creating your CHARTS Account

Select the "Log In/Sign Up" link at the top of the page or on the left menu.

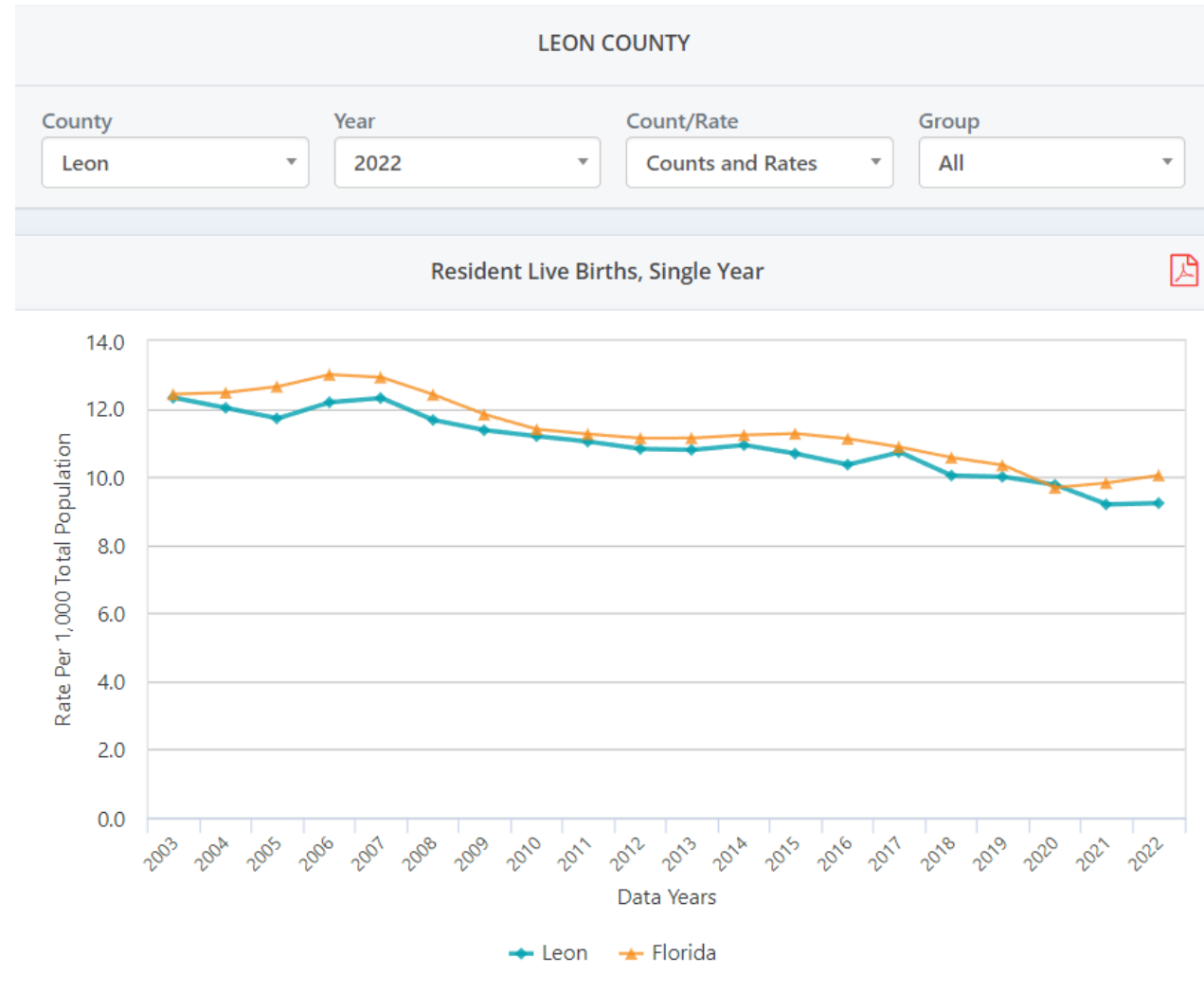

Changing Your Preferences

1. While logged into CHARTS, click the settings icon 
2. Click “Change Preferences”
3. Select your preferred county from the dropdown box
4. Subscribe or unsubscribe for CHARTS email updates using the checkbox
5. Click the “Save Changes” button

1. Click the Settings icon


